

# MAKERSPACE

The *Art on Tap* Makerspace features juried, handmade creations by local artists and craftspeople. *Art on Tap* is an art and brew community festival focusing on the following:

1) local artists and makers, 2) southern breweries and 3) an interactive and engaging experience for the community.

### EACH VENDOR RECEIVES THE FOLLOWING AS PART OF THEIR VENDOR FEE:

- A 10'x10' space at the market (tent not provided).
- Access to marketing material to cross promote the event.
- Listing on website as event vendor with link to site (if provided).
- Vendors will receive additional detailed information once selected two weeks prior to the event date.

# Eligible items include, but are not limited to:

- sculpture / pottery / stained or blown glass / woodwork
- photography
- mixed media
- jewelry
- textile art
- paintings / drawings / caricatures
- herbal / personal care
- vendors offering activities or services such as face painting or photo booths

## Ineligible items include:

- crafts made from store-bought kits or molds
- commercial reproductions or manufactured items that have been assembled
- food products

Makerspace Vendors must submit an application by August 25th along with a \$10 non-refundable fee. Vendors are choosen by August 30th and pay the final vendor fee of \$20 by September 1st. Click on the link here to complete the vendor application form. The application must be submitted with 3 color images of the work and one optional booth image.

### MAKERSPACE QUICK GLANCE:

- Makerspace hours are 2P 7PM on Saturday, September 30, 2017. Booths must be staffed for the length of event.
- Event is Rain or Shine.
- Vendors are placed in assigned locations.
- Vendors handle all sales and are responsible for all local, state, and federal taxes.
